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To CMB-S4 Spokespersons: John Carlstrom and Julian Borrill

On behalf of the CCAT-prime collaboration, we would like to express interest in exploring the possibility of using the six-meter aperture CCAT-prime telescope for CMB-S4 observations. The high-optical-throughput design of CCAT-prime was motivated in part by cosmic microwave background observations, and there is significant interest by many CCAT-prime collaborators in the planned CMB-S4 measurements. First light with CCAT-prime is scheduled for 2021, and our understanding is that CMB-S4 observations are scheduled to start in 2027. The final decision of whether CCAT-prime will be used for CMB-S4 measurements will of course be made by the CCAT-prime board. We aim to continue working with and sharing information with the CMB-S4 collaboration to facilitate this decision and continue exploring the possibility of using CCAT-prime for CMB-S4.
